- 13 detainees continue their open hunger strike in the Israeli occupation prisons.
- The occupation forces arrested 375 Palestinians during the month of July 2021, including 37 children, 13 women and member of parliament, and 90 administrative decisions, including 190 from Jerusalem, 177 from the West Bank, and 8 from Gaza.
- 70% of the administrative prisoners in Israeli occupation prisons have had their detention renewed for other periods.

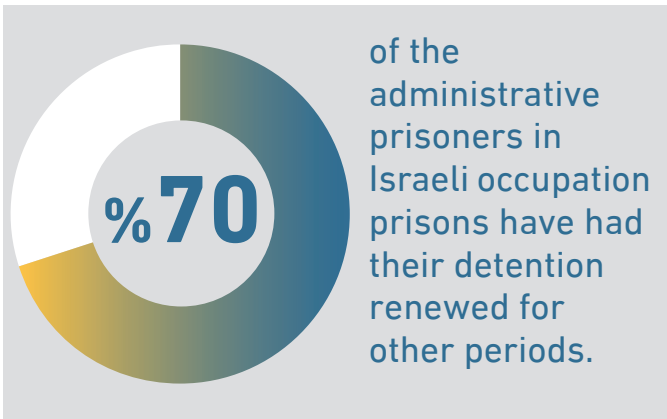

The wounded Salem Hamayel

They put me on the floor of the military jeep. They insulted and screamed at me. They took me to Hawara camp. They didn't give me any treatment.

- The Israeli Supreme Court rejects the petition submitted in the case of the two brothers Mahmoud and Kayed al-Fosfus, who are on hunger strike for the 21<sup>st</sup> consecutive day in protest of their administrative detention.
- After his arrest in connection with the recent Al-Aqsa demonstrations, the occupation forces inform the family of the detainee, Ashraf Abu Ali and his brother Nidal, from Umm al-Fahm, to evacuate their house in preparation for its demolition, without specifying a date for the demolition.
- The occupation transfers the hunger-striking detainee, Mahmoud Al-Fasfous, from Dura, south of Hebron, to the Ramleh prison clinic, in a difficult health condition and with a very high temperature.
- The wounded Salem Hamayel from Beita, who was arrested by the occupation soldiers on June 16, says in his testimony to his lawyer: "They put me on the floor of the military jeep. They insulted and screamed at me. They took me to Hawara camp. They didn't give me any treatment."
- The Military Occupation Court sentences the detainee, Mahdi Abdullah Adili, from Nablus, to 5 years in prison, in addition to a fine of 8,000 shekels.
- After 21 days of hunger strike.. the detainee Guevara Al-Namura suspends his strike after reaching an agreement represented in presenting him to the occupation court tomorrow and confirming the last administrative detention against him

without renewal, in addition to promises to reduce the period of his current detention.

- 4 detainees on hunger strike in the Negev prison: detainee Salem Ali Zaidat, detainee Kayed Muhammad Al-Namura, detainee Mujahid Mahmoud Hamed and detainee Muhammad Munir Emar, suffering from difficult health conditions and complaining of severe pain in the kidneys and stomach, extreme fatigue and inability to move in a proper manner, and the prison administration continues to abuse them.
- The detainees Alaa El-Din Ali (Qasim), and Maher Dalaysha from Al-Jalazun camp suspend their open hunger strike, which lasted 16 days, after an agreement that the current administrative detention will be the last.
- A state of extreme tension prevails in Section (3) in Ashkelon prison due to the escalation of abuse against detainees, and the tragic conditions they face, especially with the increase in the number of sick cases and the prison administration's continuing policy of medical neglect against them.

- The liberated detainee, Bayan Far'oun, meets her fiancé, Ahmed Azzam, upon his release from the occupation prisons after a 5-year detention.
- The Israeli Occupation Court renews the administrative detention of the detained activist, Islam Abu Oun, from the town of Jaba', Jenin District, for the second time, for a period of 3 months, non-renewable, so that the date of his release will be on 11/10/2021.
- The Military Occupation Court sentences the detained photojournalist Khaled Al-Zebada from Shweikeh suburb north of Tulkarm to a fine of ten thousand shekels in order to release him.

- The Israeli occupation prisons administration continues the solitary confinement, in difficult sanitary conditions, for each of the following detainees:
