- 10 detainees continue their open hunger strike in the Israeli occupation prisons.
- Transferring the cancer patient detainee, Imad Abu Ramoz from Ofer Prison to Shaarei Tzedek Hospital, after his health deteriorated.
- The Israeli Occupation Court postpones the hearing of the request to extend the solitary confinement of Sheikh Raed Salah until August 18, 2021.

- A patient with a tumor on the lungs.. The occupation prisons administration returned the detainee Nasser Abu Hamid to «Ashkelon» prison, several days after he was transferred to «Barzilai Hospital», where it was confirmed that he had a tumor on the lungs, the nature of which was not determined.
- With his empty stomach, he defeated the jailer.. The detainee, Fadi Al-Amour, from Yatta in Hebron, suspended his 23-day hunger strike after an agreement to limit his administrative detention.



- Hours after his release, after 16 years of detention, the occupation re-arrests the detainee Hamza Halayka from the town of Al-Shuyoukh, east of Hebron.
- The victory of the will.. the detainee Amjad Al-Namoura from Dura in Hebron suspends his 8-day hunger strike after an agreement not to renew his administrative detention, so that the current ruling is the last.

- The occupation prisons administration has been procrastinating in providing the necessary treatment for the detainee, Shadi Moussa, who has been suffering since his arrest from heart problems and high blood pressure, he also had a heart attack previously, and a while ago he underwent a catheterization operation at the Israeli «Soroka» hospital.
- The detainees of the «Negev» prison resume dialogue with the prison administration, return the detainees who were suppressed and transfer them to Section 2, and allow them to file a complaint against the jailers who beat the detainee Salem Zaidat.
- Detainee Ahmed Nazzal from Jenin suspends his hunger strike, which lasted 21 days, after an agreement to limit his administrative detention, so that the current administrative order will be the last, knowing that throughout the period of his strike he was kept in the cells of Megiddo Prison.
- The Israeli Occupation Prisons Administration transferred the detainee on hunger strike for the 36th consecutive day, Muhammad Munir Emar, from the Negev Prison to Ashkelon Prison.
- The occupation renews the administrative detention for five months for the detainee, leader of Hamas movement, Adnan Asfour, from Nablus.



- The Israeli military court in Ofer sentenced the prisoner Ahmed Hani Galaita from Jericho to 7 years in prison and a fine of 2,000 shekels.
- The occupation postpones the release of the detainee Muhammad Shadi Jarrar from Jenin, which was scheduled for today, after the end of his 20-month sentence.

- The Israeli occupation prisons administration continues the solitary confinement, in difficult sanitary conditions, for each of the following detainees:
