- Crying out to the world... How am I going to put my newborn in prison?!... The detainee Anhar Al-Deek sent a touching message from the prisons of the Israeli occupation: «What should I do if I give birth far from you. You know how difficult it is to give birth by caesarean section outside of prison, how will it be in prison when I am handcuffed and alone?»
- The wife of the detainee. Ahmed Hamamra. from Beit Sahour, who is on hunger strike in refusal of his administrative detention, says that her husband was severely beaten along with a number of other striking detainees in the Negev prison, and one of the detainees' rbs were broken.











- The martyrdom of the freed prisoner, Muhammad Al-Shabrawi, from Jenin camp. During his treatment journey in Turkey for cirrhosis of the liver, which he sustained during his detention in the Israeli prisons, where he spent 8 years.
- 6 detainees continue their open hunger strike in the Israeli occupation prisons.
- 11 Palestinian mothers are detained by the occupation in its prisons, and deprived of their children in harsh detention conditions and systematic abusive procedures.
- A new deterioration in the health status of the detainee Nasser Abu Hamid (49 years), from Al-Amari camp, and he was transferred again to the hospital, after new symptoms appeared on him after he had a tumor on the lungs, and so far the nature of the tumor has not been determined.
- Detainees Affairs: Israeli occupation courts have issued nearly (850) new administrative detention orders and renewals since the beginning of this year.
- The health of the detainee, Miqdad Al-Qawasmeh, deteriorated and he was transferred to the hospital, knowing that he has been on hunger strike for 39 days against his administrative detention.
- The Israeli occupation prisons administration closes the Hawara detention center, south of Nablus, after confirming that the detainee, Ali Muhammad Kharyosh, was infected with the Corona virus and had contact with 8 others.

 Detainee Salem Zaidat suspends his hunger strike, which lasted 43 days, after an agreement to release him at the end of the current administrative order next November.



- Detainee Baher Esha (47 years), from Nablus, who is currently imprisoned in Gilboa Prison, still needs special medical care, after he underwent a catheterization operation at Ikhlov Hospital.
- For the third time, the Occupation Court has extended the detention of the detainee Zuhair Daoud from Nablus until the first of next month to complete his interrogation at Petah Tikva Center. He has been in detention for 3 weeks.
