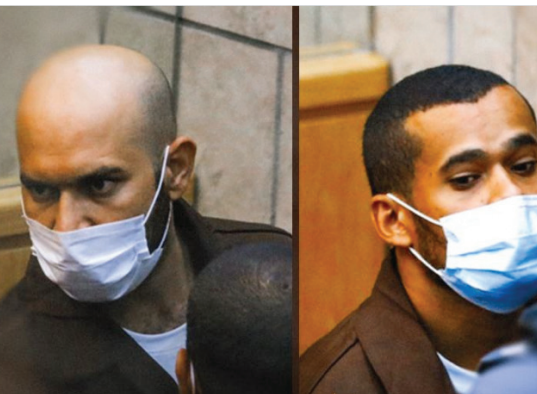


Al-Ahrar Week

- Tadamon Foundation organizes and participates in a number of solidarity activities with detainees in several European capitals.
- The martyrdom of the released detainee Hussein Masalma in the Istishari Hospital in Ramallah due to the deterioration of his health condition due to medical negligence in the Israeli occupation prisons.
- After 13 days of pursuit, the Israeli occupation forces arrested the released detainees, Ayham Kamamaji and Munadil Nfe'at, from the eastern neighborhood of Jenin.
- 7 detainees continue their open hunger strike in the Israeli occupation prisons, in refusal to administrative detention.

6 detainees

continue their open hunger strike



- Lawyer Munther Abu Ahmed during a visit to the detainees, Ayham Kamamaji and Munadil Nfe'at: The two detainees, Ayham and Munadil, were shot in the Afula area on the second day after the liberation process from the occupation prisons, and they were subjected to abuse and torture during their arrest and they need a specialized doctor to diagnose them.
- The detainees' committee: "As a result of the biopsy conducted by the detainee Nasser Abu Hamid, it confirmed the absence of a cancerous or bacterial tumor, and it is likely that the mass was an inflamed mass that needed surgery, or a damaged area in the lung."
- The Prisoner's Club: There are no serious solutions to the issue of the six detainees who are on hunger strike in rejection of their administrative detention, as they face difficult health conditions, and the occupation continues its intransigence and refusal to respond to their demand.
- The detained sheikh, Nazir Nassar, from the town of Alar, north of Tulkarm, suspends his open hunger strike for food and water due to health conditions.
- The Jerusalemite detainee Fadwa Hamada is released from solitary confinement after being isolated for more than 100 days.
- Detainee Malek Hamed from Silwad, east of Ramallah, has been detained in the Israeli Gilboa Prison for 17 days, without knowing the circumstances of his detention and isolation.
- Detainees Authority: The occupation prisons administration is still carrying out a massive campaign of abuse against detainees in Gilboa prison, and is working to transfer prisoners of section (5) to another section for the purpose of inspection, knowing that there are only two sections left in the prison.
- 25 years and imprisonment did not affect his resolve.. The leader of the great escape in Operation Freedom Tunnel, Mahmoud Abdullah Al-Ardah, begins his 26th consecutive year in the Israeli occupation prisons and is sentenced to life imprisonment in addition to 15 years.
- Five sick administrative detainees decide to boycott the occupation courts, as well as refrain from taking medication, in refusal to continue their arbitrary administrative detention. They are: Ayed Doudin, Youssef Qazzaz, Ahmed Abu Sundus, Yasser Badrasawy, and Amin Shweiki.
- Due to the deterioration of his health condition... the Israeli occupation prisons administration transferred the detainee Hisham Ismail Abu Hawash, who is on hunger strike for the 2nd consecutive day, in refusal to continue his administrative detention from the isolation of "Ofer" prison to Ramle Clinic prison.
- The Israeli Military Court of Ofer postponed hearing the appeal of the hunger striker for 73 days until 30/9/2021 due to the

prison administration's failure to bring the detainee to the courtroom.

- Al-Araj's family: The detainee, Alaa Al-Araj, was transferred to the hospital due to the deterioration of his health, as his hunger strike continued for the 51st consecutive day.
- The family of the detainee on hunger strike Miqdad Al-Qawasmi: "Our son has entered the stage of extreme danger, as he suffers from a severe drop in his heart rate, and has refused to take supplies for four days."

- The Israeli occupation prisons administration continues the solitary confinement, in difficult sanitary conditions, for each of the following detainees:

- The occupation releases the detainee Medhat Al-Issawi after the occupation authorities forced him to accept a number of conditions, including deportation from his home in Al-Isawiya for 25 days and a fine of 1,000 shekels.
- After 50 days in the cells of the Al-Maskobiya interrogation, the Israeli occupation prisons administration transferred the detainee Baraa Odeh from Ramallah to Ofer Prison. He is the son of the detainee Youssef Odeh.
