- Tadhamon Foundation organizes and participates in a number of solidarity activities with detainees in several European capitals.
- The martyrdom of the released detainee Hussein Masalma in the Istishari Hospital in Ramallah due to the deterioration of his health condition due to medical negligence in the Israeli occupation prisons.
- After 13 days of pursuit, the Israeli occupation forces arrested the released detainees, Ayham Kamamaji and Munadil Nfe'at, from the eastern neighborhood of Jenin.
- 7 detainees continue their open hunger strike in the Israeli occupation prisons, in refusal to administrative detention.

- The family of the detainee, Miqdad Al-Qawasmi: The lawyer informed us that our son was admitted to intensive care in Kaplan Hospital because of his ongoing hunger strike, in refusal of his administrative detention.
- The occupation begins abusive measures against the detainees, including considering all detainees as “dangerous and a source of threat to Israel’s security,” and a movement campaign is carried out against them so that they are transferred between rooms, and between sections in prisons.
- According to his wife: The Ramle prison administration isolates the detainee, Alaa al-Araj, in a cell that lacks the minimum necessities of life and deprives him of all his belongings, including his Qur’an. The cell is also full of insects as a punitive measure, because he asked for an additional cover because of the extreme cold he feels, and he is unable to stand there.
- 7 detainees continue their open hunger strike in the Israeli occupation prisons, in refusal to administrative detention.
- The occupation authorities have transferred the detainee Raeq Abdel Rahman Sadiq Bisharat, who has been on hunger strike for 43 days, from the Megiddo prison to the Nitzan Ramle prison due to his deteriorating health.
- The Occupation Prisons Administration transferred the detainee Nasser Abu Hamid from Ashkelon Prison to Barzilai Hospital, after his health deteriorated.

- The occupation releases the leader of (PFLP), Khaleda Jarrar, after two years of detention. She was refused release last July to participate in the funeral of her young daughter, “Suha,” who died of a severe heart attack.
- The family of the wounded detainee, Muhammad Al-Zare’ini, from Jenin, demands the disclosure of the health status of her son, who was arrested a few days ago during a military operation of the occupation in the town of Burqin, Jenin, and was arrested injured without knowing his health condition.



- The health of Jerusalemite detainee Amin Al-Shweiki is in real danger after he boycotted his diabetes medication in protest of his administrative detention.

- The occupation prisons administration extended the solitary confinement of detainee Muhammad Nawara from Ramallah in isolating Megiddo, despite its promise to him to end his isolation after he went on a hunger strike for 17 days, and he has been isolated for two months.
- The occupation court sentences the detainee, Muhammad Mahmoud al-Qut, from Hebron, to 3 years in prison and a fine of 2,000 shekels.

- The Israeli occupation prisons administration continues the solitary confinement, in difficult sanitary conditions, for each of the following detainees:

- The occupation court sentences the prisoner, Firas Al-Jaber, from Tulkarm, to 19 months in prison, in addition to a hefty fine of 35,000 shekels. He has been detained for 15 months.
