- The captive movement announces escalating steps against the Israeli occupation prison administration in response to its repressive measures against detainees.
- The Israeli occupation court presents indictments against the six detainees of the Freedom Tunnel who escaped from Gilboa prison last month, and includes only the charge of "escaping from prison." The maximum sentence is expected to be 7 years in prison, and charges were included for 5 detainees with aiding and abetting the six prisoners.
- 350 Palestinians were arrested by the Israeli occupation, including (36) children and (11) women, during the month of September.
- Despite the occupation's attempt circumvent his strike by suspending his administrative detention... Detainee Migdad Al-Qawasmi: "I will not end my strike until my freedom is achieved, and I am ready to sacrifice and pay the price."






- The list of deans of detainees who have spent more than 20 years continuously in the occupation prisons has risen to 100 detainees.
- During the reception of the wife of the captive leader, Marwan Barghouti, in Cairo..
 Ismail Haniyeh: The release of prisoners is a commitment of the Hamas leadership and comes at the top of its priorities. We are ready to offer any price for their liberation.
- Procrastination and medical negligence..
 The occupation postpones the transfer of detainee Nasser Abu Hamid to the hospital for a scheduled surgery, claiming the absence of medical staff, amid a continuous deterioration in his health.
- The commander of Operation Freedom Tunnel.. the detainee Muhammad al-Ardah suspends his hunger strike after improving some of his life requirements in the cells of Ashkelon Prison.
- The health status of the detainee Ahmed Abdel Rahman Qassem from Jenin deteriorated due to the serious injury he sustained during his detention 13 months ago. He suffered from a broken leg, a broken jaw and injuries to the neck, and he is subject to administrative detention, which has been renewed for him 3 consecutive times.
- A serious deterioration in the health of the detainee, Kayed Al-Fasfous, who is on a hunger strike in refusal to administrative detention against him, He was transferred from Al-Ramle Clinic to the Israeli Soroka Hospital.
- Six detainees of Islamic Jihad in the Negev prison are on hunger strike; in refusal of the Israeli repressive measures against

- them, and the prisoners are: A'rafat Al-Zeer, Ahmed A'lqam, Rasmi Al-Khateeb, Attia A'sakreh, Abdullah Khlouf, and Saeed Fugaha.
- The captive movement: "The occupation's practices against us will not break our resolve, and we will confront it unitedly, we will tell the whole world that there is no alternative to our freedom, which our valiant resistance seeks".
- •Hamas leader Zaher Jabareen: We deny what Al-Arabiya TV reported about the completion of an exchange deal agreement with the enemy. We call on the media to be careful and avoid spreading rumors that manipulate the feelings of the prisoners and their families, and such rumors will not succeed in putting pressure on the resistance leadership."
- The occupation intelligence issues an administrative detention order for a period of six months, against the hunger striker detainee, Shadi Abu 'Akar, from Bethlehem.
- He spent 37 years in the prisons of the occupation. The occupation transferred the detainee, MP Muhammad Abu Tir, to investigation by the occupation intelligence, and extended his detention for eleven days.
- The occupation authorities extend the detention of journalist Asim Mustafa Al-Shannar from Nablus for 9 days at the Petah Tikva interrogation center, knowing that he was arrested at Al-Karama Crossing while he was traveling abroad a week ago.
- Various symptoms of fatigue and weakness, extreme hunger and thirst, blurred vision of the Jerusalemite detainee, Ameen Shweiki,



- who continues to boycott his diabetes medication; To protest his administrative detention.
- "Mohammed and Lina" .. The detainee Islam Hamed gives birth to twin children through "smuggled sperm" from the occupation prisons.
- After an 11-month detention, the journalist Bushra Al-Taweel meets her family after her release from the occupation prisons in the absence of her father, Sheikh Jamal Al-Taweel, who has been detained for 4 months.
