






- The International Foundation for Solidarity with Detainees (Tadhamon) calls on the United Nations, the Human Rights Council and the ICRC to pay attention to the issue of detainees on hunger strike and to stop the massacre of administrative detainees and patients.
- The captive movement announces the end of the strike of the detainees of the Islamic Jihad movement, which they fought within the agreed national program to confront the repressive prison administration measures.
- After he was transferred to the intensive care unit, the occupation doctors in "Kaplan" hospital made an attempt to force-feed the hunger striker detainee, Migdad Al-Qawasmi, with solutions and supplements, while he is shackled to the bed, to break his open hunger strike against his administrative detention.
- The occupation transferred the hunger strikers, Alaa Al-Araj and Hisham Abu Hawash, to the hospital after their health deteriorated, while they were returned to Al-Ramlah prison clinic.

- In response to the message of the Jordanian parliament, the head of the Hamas political bureau, Ismail Haniyeh: "We will not hesitate to assume the responsibility for liberating the detainees now and in the future, and the conflict agenda is open with the occupation to release Palestinian and Arab prisoners, including those in Jordan, and this goal will be achieved sooner or later."
- The detainee, Mahmoud Al-Ardah, commander of the Freedom Tunnel Operation, is on an open hunger strike, rejecting the arbitrary measures against him and the rest of the detainees in the occupation prisons.
- One of the heroes of Operation Freedom Tunnel.. The Israeli occupation imposes new penalties on the isolated detainee Yaqoub Qadri, who lives in very bad conditions, while preventing him from visiting or going out to the square.
- On the tenth anniversary of the Wafaa al-Ahrar deal, the captive movement in the prisons of the Israeli occupation: "Our confidence in the resistance is great and without limits... After the battle of Sayf al-Quds, this confidence has become a certainty"
- Three female detainees announced their hunger strike in support of the hunger strikers, they are Mona Qa'adan, Amal Taqatqa, and Shatila Abu Ayada.

- The heavily armed occupation forces stormed Section 1 of Gilboa Prison, during which they carried out extensive searches inside the section, and assaulted the detainees, who numbered about (90), and the prison administration cut off their water and electricity.
- After procrastinating and upsetting her joy, the released female detainees, Nisreen Abu Kmail, is in the arms of her family, after she arrived in the Gaza Strip after 6 years of detention in the prisons of the occupation.
- The martyrdom of the liberated Syrian detainee Medhat Al-Saleh in an Israeli attack in front of the town of Majdal Shams in the occupied Golan.
- •The Hawara detention center lacks the basic necessities of human life, and the prison administration has not provided the detainees with hot water to bathe for more than two weeks, as well as the lack of blankets and giving them musty blankets that smell foul and dirty, and the lack of clothes, in addition to its intentional neglect of their illnesses and pains. It does not provide them with any treatment for their difficult health conditions.
- The International Foundation for Solidarity with Detainees (Tadhamon) announces a diploma entitled "The Palestinian Prisoners... The Case of a Homeland and the Story of a

People" with 18 training hours for a period of two months.

 Journalist Nisreen Salem and her sister Sajida were released on condition that they be kept 150 meters away from the Bab al-Amoud area in Jerusalem for 15 days, knowing that the occupation arrested them after the attack on them.
