

- The Israeli occupation authorities reactivate the administrative detention order issued against the hungerstriking detainee, Kayed Al-Fasfous, after they suspended it two weeks ago in an attempt to circumvent his right to freedom.
- The Israeli occupation arrested 424
 Palestinians, including (67) children
 and (12) women, during the month of
 September.
- The Higher Leadership Committee of Hamas Detainees: Dozens of detainees are preparing to engage in an open hunger strike in support of the six detainees who are on hunger strike in rejection of administrative detention.
- Striker Alaa Al-Araj: "If God wants us to die for our just causes, do not forget that your shortcomings were part of defining our destiny.

continue their open hunger strike in the Israeli occupation prisons.

- After he was transferred to the hospital after his health condition deteriorated.. Detainee on hunger strike, Shadi Abu Aker: I may lose sight at any moment, I suffer from severe pains in the head and stomach and feel out of balance and cannot walk or stand, yet I continue my strike until the end of this unjust administrative detention.
- The occupation prisons administration returns detainee Nasser Abu Hamid to Ashkelon prison today, after he underwent a complex surgery recently at Barzilai Hospital.
- The occupation police assaulted the detainees Yaqoub Qadri, Zakaria Al-Zubaidi and Iyad Jaradat during their trial session, to prevent them from raising the victory sign in front of the media.
- The Israeli occupation prisons administration ends the solitary confinement of 26 detainees from the Islamic Jihad movement who were isolated in the prisons of "Ashkelon", "Negev" and "Jalameh".
- The occupation transfers the wounded detainee, Muhammad al-Zara'ini, from

- Hadera Hospital to the Jalameh Investigation Center, after the serious injury he sustained nearly a month ago in the town of Burqin, west of Jenin. At the time, the occupation army announced the injury of an officer and a soldier from the "Dovdofan" special unit.
- On the National Day of Palestinian Women...
 34 Palestinian female detainees are in Israeli prisons, including 8 mothers and 7 wounded.
- Days after his release, the death of the mother of the freed detainee, Majdi Amer, from the village of Kafr Qelil, south of Nablus, who spent 16 years in the prisons of the occupation.
- The occupation arrests Ihab Rakez Howeti, 27, from Tulkarm, who was injured in a traffic accident 20 days ago, while passing through the Container Checkpoint, heading to Beit Jala Hospital to complete treatment.
- The wife of the teacher Abdel Baset Maatan, who was arrested by the occupation after raiding his house in Al-Bireh: "My husband is sick with cancer and his body cannot stand the cold and needs medication and medical follow-up."
