


- He became like a skeleton.. The occupation restores the administrative detention order against the detainee, Miqdad al-Qawasmi, who is on hunger strike, and transfers him to Al-Ramlah prison clinic and prevents his family from being with him in the hospital.
- Detainees Authority: The occupation freezes the administrative detention order against the striking detainee for the second time, and we stress that the decision does not mean canceling the detention, and it is considered a disclaimer from the occupation prisons administration for the fate of the health detainee.
- Detainee Shadi Abu Aker defeats the jailer and suspends his hunger strike, which lasted 69 days, after a decision was taken not to renew his administrative detention and to confirm his detention for 6 months.
- Announcing that the detainee, Nasser Abu Hamid, had a cancerous tumor in the lungs; Noting that he has been sentenced to life imprisonment 7 times and 50 years and has been detained since 2002. He has four detained brothers, all of whom are sentenced to life imprisonment, and the occupation is transferring him to Barzilai Israeli Hospital.





continue their open hunger strike in the Israeli occupation prisons.

- After being transferred to the investigation center in Al-Ramlah Clinic, the striking detainee, Alaa Al-Araj, said: "If God wants us to die for our just causes, do not forget that your shortcomings were part of defining our destiny".
- The Israeli occupation authorities transferred the detainee, Ayyad Al-Herimi, who is on hunger strike, from Ofer Prison to Al-Ramlah prison clinic.
- Detainees Authority: 15 detainees are sick in the Al-Ramlah prison clinic, including two detainees who are on hunger strike, suffering from difficult and worrying health conditions that are constantly worsening and witnessing a continuous decline with the passage of time.
- The "What is Hidden is Greater" program on Al-Jazeera reveals the kidnapping of two Israelis outside Palestine, and Israel is silent about them.
- Lawyer for the detainee on hunger strike, Kayed Alfasfous: "Kaed is close to clinical death, and now he cannot feel his lower part due to problems with the nervous system."
- The supreme leadership body of Hamas detainees: We hold the occupation authorities Full responsibility for the lives of the detainees who are on hunger strike in light of the dangerous health condition they have reached, which cannot be tolerated.
- He may suffer from blindness.. The sick elderly detainee, Muwafaq Oruq (78 years), who is detained in Ashkelon Prison suffers from difficult health conditions, and his condition is worsening day after day as he cannot stand.
- The Israeli occupation arrested 240
 Palestinian citizens of Jerusalem during the
 last month, including dozens of children.
 Most of them received deportation orders
 from the place from which they were

- arrested, such as Bab al-Amoud, Yusufiya Cemetery and Sheikh Jarrah.
- Jerusalemite detainee Ameen Shweiki loses 9 kilograms of weight, 49 days after boycotting his diabetes medication; To protest his administrative detention.
- After 25 days of her freedom, the occupation intelligence summons the freed detainee, the journalist and editor, Bushra Al-Taweel, tomorrow, Monday, for an interview in the Ofer camp, west of Ramallah.
- The freed detainee, released in the "Wafa' Al-Ahrar" deal and deported to Gaza, Basem Nazzal from Qabatiya, passed away due to his infection with the Corona virus.
