- The detainee Miqdad Al-Qawasmi achieves a decisive victory and ends his open hunger strike, after a battle that lasted 113 days.
- Supporter of detainees ... The death of Hamas leader and former prisoner minister, Wasfi Qabha, as a result of being infected with the Corona virus.
- Detainee Ayyad Al-Harimi, on hunger strike against his administrative detention: I suffer from a deteriorating health condition in Al-Ramlah prison clinic, and I only drink water. I will continue my strike until freedom or martyrdom.
- The detainee, Ayham Kammaji, during the occupation trial session for the detainees of Freedom Tunnel Operation: "We will come out from the door from above the ground, as we did from the ground. We will come out again, God willing."
- Detainee Yaqoub Qadri: We live in cemeteries... Our freedom is above everything. We will return to the historic Palestine.

5 DETAINEES continue their open hunger strike in the Israeli occupation prisons.

- Hamas leader Khalil al-Hayya: "We put forward a humanitarian initiative to release sick and elderly detainees in exchange for the release of information about the captured soldiers, but the occupation refused that."
- The Military Court of Appeals of the occupation in Ofer decided to reduce the duration of the administrative order issued against the detainee Hisham Abu Hawash, who has been on hunger strike for 84 days, in refusal of his administrative detention, from (6) months to (4) months.
- The administration of Ashkelon Prison transferred the detainee Nasser Abu Hmaid to Barzilai Hospital, for the third time since he underwent a surgical operation on the nineteenth of last October to remove a tumor on his lung, amid a continuous deterioration in his health.
- The Israeli Occupation Court issues a sentence of 21 years in prison for detainee Islam Hamed from Silwad, east of Ramallah.
- Detainee Abdul Aziz Marei from Salfit, sentenced to 20 years, begins his open hunger strike in solidarity with the detainees who are on hunger strike.
- Detainee Hussam Ali Al-Qawasmi from Hebron, announces his hunger strike in support of the striking detainees. He has been detained since 2014, and has been sentenced to life imprisonment three times.
- Quoting family sources: "The occupation prisons administration transferred the detainee Samer Tariq al-Issawi from the Negev prison to the cells of Nafha prison, and all attempts to visit him by lawyers were rejected, and the prison administration is still procrastinating in agreeing to visit the family's lawyer to check on him."
- The repression units of the Israeli occupation prisons administration assault a number of detainees in Shatta prison, and the events in the prison are ongoing and subject to escalation.
- The leader of Hamas, Zaher Jabareen: "The occupation's bet on the factor of time will fail, and liberating the detainees is an obligation on us."
- A new ambassador for freedom... The detainee, Muhammed Mutaib Tahaine, from Jenin, who is sentenced to 19 years in prison, gives birth to his child "Watan" through smuggled sperm.
- After leaks published by the channel about the repression of Palestinian detainees, Al Jazeera: "The occupation reopens an investigation into the repression and torture of detainees in the Negev prison in 2019, and begins taking testimonies from detainees who were tortured."
- The wife of the detainee Maher al-Hashlamoun, in his eighth year of detention: "On this day, God honored us, raised our remembrance among the people, and made us more patient and conscientious."
- Jerusalemite detainee Ameen Shwaiki continues his strike for diabetes treatment for the 58th consecutive day in protest of his administrative detention.
