- The occupation prisons administration mad campaign Palestinian female detainees in "Damoon" prison, beating them, injuring several female detainees, and isolating 3 of them.
- Detainees in occupation prisons: "We will not allow the sanctions to remain, and the situation will not return to what it was without the return of the isolated detainees and the cessation of all measures taken due to the recent events and the response to the rest of the female detainees' demands."
- "Between life and death"... The detainee Hisham Abu Hawash continues his hunger strike for the 132nd consecutive day against his administrative detention in the Israeli occupation prisons.





- The conditions inside the prisons are heading towards an escalation due to the lack of response of the occupation to restore things to the way they were, especially among the female detainees.
- Detainee Yousef al-Mabhouh stabs an Israeli jailer in Nafha prison in retaliation for the female detainees in Damoun Prison, and his fate is still unknown, and warnings of a real danger to his life.
- Detainees Media: The fate of the detainees of Section 12 in Nafha prison is still ambiguous, and the fate of 80 detainees is unknown after they were subjected to systematic repression by the occupation prisons administration.
- The family of the detainee Hisham Abu Hawash: "The occupation is committing a crime against our detained son, who is on hunger strike, to force him to end his ongoing strike, and official medical reports indicate the possibility of his death at any moment."
- The Higher Leadership Committee of Hamas Detainees: We have prepared ourselves for a long and open battle with the administration of the occupation prisons.
- Zaher Jabarin, head of the Hamas Detainees, Wounded and Martyrs' Affairs Office: "We have informed the mediators and the Egyptians that attacks on female detainees will not go unpunished, and any crossing of red lines will have repercussions on the region."
- Administrative detainees in occupation prisons decide to boycott the occupation courts for administrative detention, starting

from the beginning of next month (1/1/2022).

- The occupation prisons administration decided to stop the families' visits to all Hamas detainees in prisons.
- The occupation sentences the detainee, Qassem Asafra, to life imprisonment and 40 years for killing a soldier south of Bethlehem more than two years ago. He was also sentenced to pay a fine of one and a half million shekels and another 60,000 shekels for another operation he carried out in 2011.
- Sentenced to 11 life imprisonment.. The occupation prisons administration transfers detainee Thaer Hammad to solitary confinement in "Nafha" prison.
- The family of the detainee Hussam Hassan Abu Hussein from Hebron demands his immediate release due to his poor health, as he suffers from thalassemia and lives with one kidney, He was transferred two days ago to Al-Ramlah Hospital in a difficult health condition. He has been in administrative detention for a year.
- After her family waited for hours, the occupation postponed the release of the detainee. Enas Asafra.
- The death of the mother of the oldest Jerusalemite detainee, leader Mahmoud Issa, from the town of Anata, east of Jerusalem.
- Jerusalemite detainee Ameen Shweiki continues his strike for diabetes treatment for the 100th consecutive day in protest of his administrative detention.
