- The International Foundation for Solidarity with Prisoners of War (Solidarity): "We strongly condemn the abuse that our heroic detainees are subjected to through the film Amira, which comes at a time when grievances and violations against our prisoners multiply, to form a poisoned dagger in the face of the humanitarian smuggled sperm initiative."
- After a wave of anger that swept social media... Jordan TV: The Royal Film Commission of Jordan decides to withdraw the movie "Amira" from the Oscars 2022 race.
- Detainee Hisham Abu Hawash continues his hunger strike for the 118th day in a row against his administrative detention in Israeli prisons.
- During the Last month, The Israeli occupation arrested 402 Palestinians including 66 children and 3 women.

- The administration of Assaf Harofeh Hospital refuses to keep the hunger striker Hisham Abu Hawash inside the hospital because of his poor health and his refusal to take supplies, and the occupation prisons administration sends him back to Al-Ramlah prison clinic.
- The occupation released him in a state of nervous breakdown.. Brother of the released detainee, Nabil Rajoub: "My brother is in a difficult health condition as a result of solitary confinement, and we demand the disclosure of what happened to him inside the prison, and there are bruises on his head."
- He lost more than half of his weight.. Brother of the hunger striker, Hisham Abu Hawash: "My brother suffers from poor eyesight and hearing, complete loss of concentration in his mind, inability to speak, and he cannot move his limbs."
- Jordanian actress Juliet Awad, the heroine of the series "Al-Taghriba al-Falasteniya": The movie "Amira" is one of the dirtiest types of normalization because it offends the detainees, and whoever produced and represented in the movie "Amira" must be hit with shoes, and the writer of the movie "Amira" has a Zionist mentality and must be prevented from showing, and Arab channels ignore Palestine because it is running behind normalization.
- Jordanian artist Sari Al-As'ad: The movie "Amira" carries a very large abuse of Palestinian detainees, and no one has the right to question the lineage of the great heroic prisoners who are under the fire of

the occupation, and those who want to walk on the red carpet have no right to offend the nation's constants, and the movie "Amira" does not represent Jordanians.

- The wife who had her first childbearing experience through smuggled sperm .. Umm Muhammad Al-Zaben, wife of the detainee Ammar Al-Zaben: "The Amira movie will not shake the will of the families of the detainees and their wives, and the detainees who are engaged in epics against the occupation know very well that this is an Israeli novel in an Arab tongue."
- Sana Daqqa, wife of detainee Walid Daqqa: "The smile of my daughter, "Melad", the liberated sperm, is better than all those in charge of the film Amira and the occupation state."
- Head of the Prisoner Club Qaddoura Fares: "Stopping the screening of the film Amira is a step in the right direction, but the film crew should have closed the case permanently instead of calling for the formation of a committee to watch the film, and if they want to know what is required of them, they should read the statement of our heroic detainees."
- The Israeli occupation authorities return dozens of families of Palestinian detainees heading to visit their sons in the "Negev" and "Ofar" prisons, claiming that they did not receive the third dose of the anti-Coronavirus vaccine.
- Lawyer Muhammad Mahmoud: "The Jerusalemite student Nofouth Hammad was subjected to torture and insults and they served her food late at night, and she denies



all the charges against her."

- The Occupation Court refuses to reduce the sentence of 22 months for the Jerusalemite detainee Iman Al-A'war.
- The list of deans of detainees in the occupation prisons has risen to 111, since

they have been detained for 20 years or more continuously.

- Jerusalemite detainee Ameen Shwaiki continues his strike for diabetes treatment for the 86th consecutive day in protest of his administrative detention.
