



- He fell into a coma and could be martyred at any moment.. Detainee Hisham Abu Hawash has been on a hunger strike for 139 days, in refusal of his administrative detention in the Israeli occupation prisons.
- The prisoner movement in the occupation prisons announces the start of the boycott of the administrative detainees of the occupation courts within the comprehensive national project.
- •Wa'ed Association: Doctors of "Asaf Harofeh" Hospital declare a state of emergency after the deteriorating health condition of detainee Hisham Abu Hawash and the family asked the Red Cross to go to the hospital after preventing his wife from being in his room.
- An increase of 60% over the previous year..
 About 8,000 Palestinians were arrested by the occupation during the year 2021.





- Detainee Youssef Talaat al-Mabhouh, who carried out the stabbing attack in Nafha prison a few days ago, is isolated in solitary confinement in tragic circumstances in the "Ohelikdar" prison in Beersheba, where he suffers from fractures in his hand, foot, chest and right jaw, and has never been seen by a doctor.
- The number of detainees sentenced to life imprisonment in the occupation prisons has increased to (546), after the occupation courts issued two new life sentences.
- The Israelioccupation prisons administration informed 9 detainees in Nafha prison who were subjected to repression by transferring them to Shata and Megiddo prisons.
- The administration of the Israeli Ofer Prison is executing a crime against the administrative detainee, Abd al-Basit Ma'atan, 48y, from the town of Burqa, Ramallah. They are deliberately delaying in providing him with the necessary treatment, which has recently significantly worsened his health.
- Member of Hamas' political bureau, Zaher Jabarin: "Having 4 soldiers does not mean that we will rest, but there are bodies that work day and night and do not waste a single minute in order to achieve a heroic deal, and the operations of capturing soldiers are strategic."
- The Israeli Occupation Court in Ofer sentenced the prisoner Youssef Saeed Attia Zuhour to life imprisonment and 15 years and a fine of one and a half million shekels.
- The Israeli Occupation Court sentenced the

- detainee Qusai Abu Hatta from Hebron to 19 years in prison and a compensation of 100,000 shekels, and a fine of 4000 shekels, after he was accused of stabbing a settler in Hebron and trying to stab others.
- Occupation proves the administrative detention order for the lawyer Bashir Al-Khairy for a period of 6 months, despite his boycott of the military occupation court, and his failure to appear or his lawyer in the judicial review session.
- Two days before Freedom Day.. the occupation court renewed the administrative detention of activist and poet Mahmoud Ayyad (Al-Murabit) for 4 months for the fourth time in a row.
- The detainee, Enas Asafra, from the town of Beit Kahil in Hebron, is free after spending about 30 months in the Israeli occupation prisons.
- Jerusalemite detainee Ameen Shweiki continues his strike for diabetes treatment for the 107th consecutive day in protest of his administrative detention.
