- He triumphed with his empty stomach.. The detainee Hisham Abu Hawash is victorious over administrative detention after 141 days of continuous strike, and he will be released on February 26th.
- The family of the detainee, the cancer patient, Nasser Abu Hamid: The doctor assured the family that a severe infection affected his lungs, which was caused by a bacterial infection that led to the collapse of the work of his lungs and his immune system, which led to his coma.
- Administrative detainees in Israeli occupation prisons continue their boycott of the occupation courts for the fourth consecutive day to demand an end to the policy of administrative detention under the slogan "Our decision is freedom."





- A number of Palestinian detainees were infected with the Corona virus.
- Dean of Palestinian detainees.. Detainee Karim Younes (63 years), a resident of the village of Ara in the occupied territories, begins his 40th and final year in the occupation prisons.
- The mother of the detainee Nasser Abu Hamid: "The occupation refuses to reassure me about Nasser, and I hope the resistance will release my children in the coming prisoner swap."
- The occupation army informs the family of the prisoner Mahmoud Jaradat of their intention to demolish the apartment in which he lives. The occupation accuses him of carrying out Operation Homesh near Nablus on December 16, 2021.
- The detainee, Muhammad Hashem Nawara, from the town of Al-Mazraa al-Gharbia, Ramallah, has started a hunger strike for 4 days, due to the prison administration's refusal to end his 6 months of isolation. He was transferred from the isolation of Megiddo prison to the isolation of Gilboa prison recently, and he has been detained for 20 years and sentenced to life imprisonment.
- The Higher Leadership Committee of Hamas detainees announces the return of the conditions inside the prisons to what they were before the revenge operation for the female detainees, after reaching an agreement to end the state of tension that lasted 17 days

- The occupation files an indictment against Sheikh Hassan Youssef for his speech at the funeral of the martyr Fadi Abu Shkhaydam in the Shuafat refugee camp in Jerusalem.
- The Israeli Occupation Court sentenced the detainee, Montaser Shalabi, to life imprisonment twice, in addition to a fine of 2.5 million shekels.
- The researcher in the affairs of prisoners and detainees, Abdel Nasser Farwana: 600 sick detainees out of the total number of detainees in the occupation prisons, and their number reached (4,600), some of whom suffer from chronic and serious diseases such as cancer.
- The occupation arrested about 8,000 Palestinians during the year 2021, including 1,266 arrests against children, with an increase of 60% over the previous year.
- The Military Occupation Court sentences the wounded detainee Arqam Harsha from Tulkarm to three years in prison and a fine of 5.000 shekels.
- The occupation isolates the detained Sheikh Muhammad Youssef Jaradat in Hadarim Prison, who is one of the detainees in connection with Operation Homesh.
- Jerusalemite detainee Ameen Shweiki continues his strike for diabetes treatment for the 114th consecutive day in protest of his administrative detention.
