

"Palestine's free women"... a media campaign introductory to Palestinian female detainees launched by the International Foundation for Solidarity with Prisoners (TADHAMON) in partnership with the Palestinian Ministry of Women's Affairs to shed light on the reality of female detainees and their suffering, and symbolize them as icons of the Palestinian struggle.



- The detainee, Nasser Abu Hamid, is still in a coma and under respirators, and his mother announces a hunger strike until he is released to receive treatment outside of captivity.
- The detainee. Hisham Abu Hawash. was infected with the Corona virus in "Asaf Harofeh" hospital inside the occupied territories, 12 days after the end of his hunger strike.





- 413 cases of corona among detainees in the occupation prisons since the beginning of the epidemic, 50 of them during the current year, including 7 female detainees, and the detainee Hisham Abu Hawash.
- Detainees Club: (131) arrest cases were recorded in the Negev since the beginning of the current confrontation, during which the detainees were subjected to a high level of violence and various attacks, We call for the current state of advocacy for detainees to be extended to include advocacy for our people in the Negev who face a threat that represents the core of the conflict with the occupation.
- The detainees in "Nafha and Ashkelon" prisons decide to return the meals tomorrow to pressure the Israeli occupation prisons administration to visit the brothers of the sick prisoner Nasser Abu Hamid in the hospital.
- Detainee Muhammad Al-Ardah suspends his open hunger strike, which lasted 4 days, to give the occupation prison administration an opportunity to respond to his demands to improve his conditions and end the penalties imposed on him.
- For the 16th day in a row, the administrative detainees continue their boycott of the occupation courts, as part of their rejection of the administrative detention policy. It is reported that their number is about 500 detainees, including four minors, and one female detainee, Shuroog Al-Badan.
- Brother of the detainee, Hisham Abu Hawash:
 The occupation is trying to liquidate Hisham

- before releasing him, by transmitting the Corona virus to his weak body.
- The detainee, Muhammad Nawara, from Ramallah, suspends his hunger strike, which lasted for 11 days, against the order of his solitary confinement, after promising to end his isolation on the 21st of this January.
- •The Israeli occupation intelligence rearrests the released detainee Areen Al-Za'anin from the gate of "Raymond" desert prison immediately after his release after spending 9 months in the occupation prisons and summons his brother Imad for interrogation.
- •The occupation transfers the detained student at Birzeit University, Qassam Nakhleh, to Ofer prison, after he was kidnapped by special forces in front of the university two days ago. He suffers from broken leg and knee after the soldiers assaulted him during arrest.
- Walla Hebrew website: A Palestinian was sentenced to 28 months in prison and a fine of 18,000 shekels; Accused of pouring a cup of boiling coffee on a settler at Bab al-Amud in Jerusalem.
- Jerusalemite detainee Ameen Shweiki continues his strike for diabetes treatment for the 121st consecutive day in protest of his administrative detention.
