- The occupation prevents the family of the sick detainee Nasser Abu Hamid, the Red Cross crews, and any other party from visiting him, which indicates the seriousness of his health condition.

- Zaher Jabarin, a member of the Hamas political bureau: "We have put clear names to be released in any future exchange deal."

- The Israeli occupation authorities transferred the detainee Hisham Abu Hawash from Assaf Harofeh Hospital to AL-Ramlah prison, despite his difficult health condition and infection with the Corona virus.

- Detainees Club: 413 cases of corona among detainees in the occupation prisons since the beginning of the epidemic, 50 of them during the current year, including 7 female detainees and the detainee Hisham Abu Hawash.

- On hunger strike 4 days ago... Israeli occupation intelligence transferred the captive PFLP leader Hussam Al-Razza (67 years) from Nablus to administrative detention for six months.
- For the 23rd consecutive day... the administrative detainees in the occupation prisons continue their boycott of the occupation courts to demand an end to the policy of administrative detention under the slogan "Our decision is freedom."
- The occupation renews the administrative detention of the detainee Mujahid al-Najjar from Silwad for 4 months, as he was scheduled to be released tomorrow after his strike for 43 days earlier in rejection of his administrative detention.
- The number of "Freedom Ambassadors", who are the children of detainees who were born through sperm smuggling operations, increased to (104) children, after the detainee, "Yousri Al-Julani" gave birth to twin girls.
- "Childhood being pursued and youth behind bars." Jerusalemite detainee Nadim Safadi is deprived of discussing his graduation project at Birzeit University because he was arrested by the occupation several months ago. He was arrested more than 20 times, the first of which was when he was only 13 years old.

- The occupation arrests Abdel Qader Khuzaymieh, a disabled person with special needs, with his son, Nabil Khuzaymieh, after storming and searching his house in the town of Qabatiya in Jenin.
- The occupation army announces that the detainees' family, Ghaith and Omar Jaradat, have given a decision to demolish their house in the town of Silat Al-Harithiya, west of Jenin.
- PFLP detainees refuse to go out for security checks in Ramon prison, and the occupation forces storm the rooms and release the detainees handcuffed, and the detainees threaten to escalate and transfer protest steps to all prisons if their demands are not met.
- The Occupation Court sentenced the Jerusalemite detainee, Muhammad Bassam Obaid, from the town of Al-Isawiya, to 24 months in actual prison, and he has been in detention for 9 months. He had his first child while in prison and saw her for the first time in the courtroom.
- Jerusalemite detainee Ameen Shweiki continues his strike for diabetes treatment for the 128th consecutive day in protest of his administrative detention.
