- Ofer prison administration imposes collective “punishments” against the detainees, such as depriving them of visits in addition to financial fines, as part of its ongoing attack against detainees, in an attempt to pressure them and discourage them from continuing their ongoing battle to repel the prison administration’s plans that aim to rob the detainees their achievements and impose a new reality on their prison life.



- The life of the detainee, Nasser Abu Hamid, is still in danger, as he was visited by his relatives last Thursday in Al-Ramlah prison clinic, and he cannot remember due to the coma that lasted for three weeks while he was in Barzilai Hospital.

- The family of the detainee Ahmed Manasra: the detainee Ahmed Manasra was severely beaten by the occupation forces when he was arrested, which led to a fracture in his skull and a hematoma inside the skull. Psychological disorder as a result of the oppressive conditions and violence to which he was subjected.
- The detainee, Ahmed Ayoub Obeida from Al-Jalazun camp, attacked two Israeli jailers with beatings and punches, in response to the occupation's repression and its continuous abuse of detainees in Nafha prison.
- Zaher Jabarin, head of the Hamas office of martyrs, detainees and wounded: We deny what was reported by the Hebrew media about progress in the file of the prisoner exchange deal, and there has been no progress in the deal until now, because the occupation has not taken any serious steps regarding this file.
- The detainee Hisham Abu Hawash gets his freedom after an administrative detention during which he went on a hunger strike for 141 days.
- The occupation releases the freed detainee Miqdad Al-Qawasmi from Hebron after an administrative detention during which he went on a hunger strike for 114 days.
- Detainee Muhammad Jaradat in a letter

leaked from his prison to his family: I was tortured so severely that I was taken to the hospital several times during the investigation of "Homush" operation.

- He announced a hunger strike...the occupation prisons administration stormed the room of the detained writer Bassem al-Khandaqji, ghosted him and wreaked havoc in it before confiscating his literary possessions.
- The detainee, Muhammad Nawara from Ramallah, has been on hunger strike for 15 days, in refusal to be held in solitary confinement in Gilboa Prison. He was transferred to the hospital this evening, due to his deteriorating health condition.
- The detainee, Ahmed Abdel-Qader Khuzaymiyah, from the town of Qabatiya, south of Jenin, announces his hunger strike, in refusal of his administrative detention.
- The Detainees Authority: 25 new infections of the Corona virus were recorded among the detainees in "Megiddo" detention center.
- Detainees Media: The number of detainees infected with the Corona virus is increasing in Raymond Prison, and the prison administration continues to refrain from isolating those infected with the virus and does not apply health measures.
- Occupation forces arrest the blind sheikh and the freed detainee, Ezz El-Din Amarneh, after storming his house in the town of Ya'bad, southwest of Jenin
- The Israeli occupation authorities decided to hold a sudden court session for the Jerusalemite detainee, Fadwa Hamada.
- Jerusalemite detainee Ameen Shweiki continues his strike for diabetes treatment for the 163rd consecutive day in protest of his administrative detention.

The Israeli occupation prisons administration continues the solitary confinement, in difficult sanitary conditions, for each of the following detainees:
