- The International Foundation for Solidarity with Detainees (Tadamon) participates in the activities of The Palestinian Diaspora conference, organizes a pavilion on the issue of detainees, and presents the " detainees' Ambassadors" initiative.
- The captive movement: Our uprising will not stop unless our demands are met, and we are moving towards a comprehensive strike in all prisons as a result of the intransigence of the occupation.
- For the 66th day in a row... administrative detainees in the occupation prisons continue to boycott the occupation courts, demanding an end to the policy of administrative detention under the slogan "Our decision is freedom."





- Handala Center: Elderly detainee Husam Al-Ruzza (67 years), from Nablus, announces that he has entered an open hunger strike to protest against his administrative detention.
- The detainee, Muhammad Nawara, from Al-Mazraa Al-Gharbia, north of Ramallah, suspends his open hunger strike, which lasted 21 days, after his demand was met.
- •The family of the leader Sheikh Hassan Al-Wardian from Bethlehem expresses its concern for his life as he has continued his administrative detention in the occupation prisons for 11 months, and he has been on strike from taking insulin for the sixth day in protest against his continued arbitrary administrative detention.
- The occupation releases the former Minister of Jerusalem, Khaled Abu Arafa (60 years), after 15 months in administrative detention, knowing that he has been deported from the city of Jerusalem for 10 years.
- For the 178th day... the Israeli occupation authorities are still isolating the detainee Malik Hamed from Silwad, east of Ramallah, without the slightest requirements for life.

- Detainees Media: The Occupation Prisons Administration confiscates all electrical equipment from Section 22 of Ofer Prison on the pretext that one of the detainees beat a jailer during a raid and search operation in the section yesterday afternoon, and Ofer Prison Administration transferred 6 detainees to the cells.
- The death of the father of the Jerusalemite detainee, Muhammad Al-Jaouni, from the town of Kafr Aqab, north of Jerusalem. He has been detained since May 30, 2021 and is still detained and currently in Ramon Desert Prison. The Occupation Court rejects the request for temporary release to participate in his father's farewell.
- She left before she freely embraced her son... The death of the mother of the detainee, Wael Abu Dalal, from Ramallah, who was sentenced to 21 years in prison and has been detained since 2006.
- Jerusalemite detainee Ameen Shweiki continues his strike for diabetes treatment for the 170th consecutive day in protest of his administrative detention.
