## Arrests



- (Tadamon) in its annual report: The Israeli occupation arrested more than 8000 Palestinians during the past year 2021.
- The Captive National Movement: The Supreme National Emergency Committee decided to start an open hunger strike on 25/3/2022 until our legitimate demands are met, after the intransigence of the prison administration and the failure to respond to our demands.
- Detainees' institutions: 448 Palestinians arrested by the Israeli occupation, including (71) children and (10) women, during the month of February, and 203 administrative detention orders have been issued since the beginning of the current year 2022.

- The health condition of detainee Nasser Abu Hamid in Al-Ramlah Prison portends double dangers to his fate, after the results of the recent examination showed that there is a great possibility that confirms that the cancer has begun to spread to other parts of his body after it spread in the lungs.
- Detainee Khalil Awawda (40 years), from Hebron, continues his open hunger strike for the 18th consecutive day, in refusal to continue his administrative detention, knowing that he is in Ofer prison.
- Head of the Detainees' Affairs Authority, Qadri Abu Bakr: The detainees are currently conducting internal consultations on how to respond to the prison administration's steps, in protest against the new sanctions imposed on them.
- Detainees Authority: The occupation prisons administration confiscates cooking equipment and deprives detainees in detention centers of several types of vegetables and fruits.
- Detainees Club: "Occupation jailers in (Megiddo) brutally attack the sick detainee Khalil Misbah from Jenin, and we hold the prison administration full responsibility for his life and fate."
- A state of extreme tension in the Negev desert prison after Friday prayer preachers were transferred to the cells, and the detainees began to shout takbeer and knock on the doors in refusal to do so, and the prison administration is threatening to
- The Public Prosecution Office of the Israeli occupation rejects the decision of the early release of the sick (Sheikh of Detainees), Fuad Al-Shobaki, the detainee.
- The family of the detained Sheikh Hassan Al-Wardian (67 years old) warns of danger threatening him as he continues his hunger strike in the occupation prisons for the 26th consecutive day.
- Detainees Affairs Authority: Administrative detainee Areen al-Zaanin boycotts the court authorized to confirm his administrative detention decision for a period of six months, to be the first administrative detainee from Jerusalem enters the list of boycotts of administrative courts.
- The occupation transfers the detained boy, Muhammad Jihad Hamdan, to Hadassah Hospital, after he was tortured and beaten since his arrest the day before yesterday in Ramallah.
- The Israeli occupation authorities sentenced the Jerusalemite Mahmoud Abu Taa'a to 14 months in prison and his brother Karim Abu Ta'aa to 12 months in prison.
- Repressive forces stormed Section 13 of "Nafha" prison, and the occupation prisons administration isolates two detainees, claiming that there is a hole inside the visiting room.
- After a 22-month detention, the detainee Iman Al-Awar from occupied Jerusalem is enjoying freedom.



- Under the slogan "Our decision is freedom"... the administrative detainees in the occupation prisons continue to boycott the occupation courts for the 79th consecutive day to demand an end to the policy of administrative detention.
- Jerusalemite detainee Ameen Shweiki continues his strike for diabetes treatment for the 184th consecutive day in protest of his administrative detention.

The Israeli occupation prisons administration continues the solitary confinement, in difficult sanitary conditions, for each of the following detainees:
