- The captive national movement: We declare our victory and suspend our hunger strike after reaching an agreement to stop the occupation's incursion on us and achieve many of the demands and achievements that we have worked on for years.
- The International Foundation for Solidarity with Detainees of War (Tadamon) participates in a stand in solidarity with the Palestinian detainees after their victory and the suspension of their hunger strike in front of the Red Cross headquarters in the Lebanese capital, Beirut.
- The International Foundation for Solidarity with Detainees of War (Tadamon) in cooperation with the European Alliance in Support of Palestinian Detainees, begins the project (A Tribute To Our Prisoners).

- On Mother's Day...the Israeli occupation continues to detain ten mothers, and they are among the 31 detainees who are imprisoned in "Damoona" prison.
- The Israeli occupation refuses to provide treatment to the detainee, Mahmoud Abu Warda, from Al-Fawwar camp, south of Hebron, after a cancerous tumor appeared over the left kidney, knowing that he has been administratively detained for five months.
- The detainee, Yaqoub Qadri, is subjected to poor isolation conditions in the "Eshel" prison, and the occupation authorities refuse to provide him with the necessary treatment, as he suffers from pains and aches in his right hand, shoulder and left foot as a result of the beatings by (Al-Nahshon) forces.
- For the 26th day in a row, the detainee Khalil Awawda (40 years), from the town of Idna, west of Hebron, continues his hunger strike, in refusal to be administratively detained in the occupation prisons.
- The Red Cross: "The Israeli side informed us of the decision to resume the family visits program for the families of detainees in the Gaza Strip as of Tuesday, March 29, 2022, and the same categories of detainees will be allowed to receive visits as they were before the Corona pandemic."

- According to her husband, the detainee, Fadwa Hamada, is staying in Richon Hospital in Haifa after sustaining a broken leg, and her trial in absentia has been postponed to May 1.
- Generals of patience.. The rise of the deans of detainees, who have spent more than 20 years continuously in the occupation prisons, to reach (153) detainees, with new detainees entering their 21st year in a row.
- The Israeli occupation continues to isolate the detainee Malik Ahmed Hamed from Silwad, east of Ramallah, for the 202nd consecutive day, without the minimum necessities of life.
- The released detainee, Saleh Abu Mokh, from Baqa al-Gharbiyye, in the occupied interior, has been groomed after 35 years of captivity in the prisons of the Israeli occupation.
- The Israeli Salem Military Court postpones the trial of the detainee, Mona Qaadana, from Jenin in absentia, until the fourth of April. She is a freed detainee who was re-arrested 12 months ago.
- Under the slogan "Our decision is freedom"... the administrative detainees in the occupation prisons continue to boycott the occupation courts for the 86th consecutive day to demand an end to the policy of administrative detention.
- Jerusalemite detainee Ameen Shweiki continues his strike for diabetes treatment for the 191st consecutive day in protest of his administrative detention.
