
## Al-Ahrar Week

- The Israeli occupation refuses to provide treatment to the detainee, Mahmoud Abu Warda, from Al-Fawwar camp, south of Hebron, after a cancerous tumor appeared over the left kidney, knowing that he has been administratively detained for five months.
- Detainees Club: "A new deterioration occurred in the health condition of the detainee, Musa Soufan (47 years), from Tulkarm, as medical examinations proved that he had a lung tumor."
- "Tadamon" Foundation's information report: 370 detainees were infected with the Corona virus during the year 2021.







- The Military Occupation Court sentences the detainee, Mahmoud Kabha, from the village of Tora, southwest of Jenin, to life imprisonment on charges of killing a settler about a year and a half ago.
- For the 32nd day in a row, the detainee Khalil Awawda (40 years), from the town of Ithna, west of Hebron, continues his hunger strike in order to reject his administrative detention in the occupation prisons.
- Abdel Nasser Farwana: 548 detainees in the occupation prisons are serving life sentences (for life) once or several times, and the highest prison sentence is Abdullah Barghouti, who has been sentenced to life imprisonment 67 times.
- After stopping it for several years, the families of detainees in the Gaza Strip go to visit their sons in the occupation prisons through the Beit Hanoun checkpoint in the northern Gaza Strip.
- Detainees Club: "Activating the public phone of the detainees in Al-Ramlah clinic prison after what the detainees recently accomplished in their battle that lasted for several months."
- After 6 months of administrative detention, the occupation disturbs the joy of the Jerusalemite detainee Majed Al-Jubeh and extends his detention for the third time in a row, after he was scheduled to be released on Sunday.

- The occupation sentences the detainee,
   Faisal Luay Obaid, from Al-Esawiya, east
   Jerusalem, to 4 and a half years in prison
   and a fine of 5000 shekels.
- Only two months after his release, the occupation authorities transferred the Jerusalemite detainee Amir Ezghair to administrative detention for a period of three months.
- She left before embracing her son freely... The death of Hajja Umm Khalil Abeda, the mother of the detainee Ibrahim Abeda from Bethlehem, who has been detained since 2002 and sentenced to life imprisonment.
- The death of Hajja Aisha Al-Khatib, mother of the detainee Sheikh Fathi Raja Al-Khatib, who was sentenced to life imprisonment 29 times from Qafin, near Tulkarm.
- Under the slogan "Our decision is freedom"...
   the administrative detainees in the
   occupation prisons continue to boycott the
   occupation courts for the 93rd consecutive
   day to demand an end to the policy of
   administrative detention.
- Jerusalemite detainee Ameen Shweiki continues his strike for diabetes treatment for the 198th consecutive day in protest of his administrative detention.
