- The administration of Al-Ramlah Prison Hospital transferred all 17 sick detainees to quarantine after the emergence of an infection with the Corona virus among them.
- On the Day of the Palestinian Child, about 160 minors are detained in the prisons of (Ofar, Damon and Megiddo), and the occupation has arrested about 19,000 children since 2000.
- 470 Palestinians were arrested by the occupation, including (64) children, (7) women, and 176 from Jerusalem, during the month of March.

- Detainee Khalil Musa Misbah from Jenin camp continues his hunger strike for the sixth consecutive day, in refusal to be isolated for 36 days, in the cells of Ashkelon Detention Center.
- The occupation prisons administration transferred the hunger striker detainee for the 39th day in a row, Khalil Awawda from the isolation of Ofer Prison to Al-Ramlah prison clinic, after his health condition deteriorated.
- Detainees Club: About 400 administrative detention orders issued by the occupation against Palestinians since the beginning of this year.
- Going on a hunger strike for the 39th day in a row.. The wife of the detainee Khalil Awawda: My husband suffers from severe headaches and constant nausea, he even vomits the water he drinks, and he lost consciousness twice, and he goes on strike without any support until he gets his freedom.
- The occupation prevents Umm Nasser Abu Hamid from visiting her children upon her arrival to Al-Ramlah prison.
- He went on a medication strike that posed a threat to his life. The Occupation Court confirmed the detainee Sheikh Hassan Wardian from Bethlehem, a new administrative extension for another four months.
- Quoting her family: the detainee, Bushra Al-Taweel, was isolated for several days and deprived of the cantina and visits because the detainees expressed their joy at the "Bnei Brak" operation last week.
- The Occupation Court issues a decision to demolish the home of detainee Omar Jaradat, for allegedly participating in Operation Homesh.
- Lawyer and detainee Salah Hammouri is filing a lawsuit in France against the Israeli company NSO because his phone was hacked with the Pegasus program.

- He was scheduled to be released on Thursday.. The occupation renewed the administrative detention of Hamas leader Sheikh Rizk Rajoub from Dura, south of Hebron, for a period of four months.
- Detainees Club: A new deterioration occurred in the health status of the administrative detainee, who is ill with cancer, Abdel Baset Maatan (48 years old), from the town of Burqa, Ramallah District.
- The occupation transfers the detainee Abdul Rahman Al-Saadi to Afula Hospital, after the Dovdovan unit assaulted him during his arrest.
- The Military Occupation Court postponed the trial of the detainee Yasmine Shaaban from Jenin until 11/4/2022. She is a liberated detainee who spent 5 years in detention, and was re-arrested on the first of last March.
- For the 14th time in a row, Salem Military Court postponed the trial of the detainee Mona Qaadon from Jenin, until the ninth of next May. She is a liberated detainee who was re-arrested 13 months ago.
- Quoting her husband: "After she broke her leg as a result of handcuffing her"... the Jerusalemite detainee Fadwa Hamada undergoes a foot surgery.
- The occupation handed over to the Deputy Director of the Islamic Endowments Department in Jerusalem, Najeh Bakirat, a decision to banish him from Al-Aqsa Mosque for a period of 6 months, after summoning him for investigation.
- Under the slogan "Our decision is freedom"... the administrative detainees in the occupation prisons continue to boycott the occupation courts for the 100th consecutive day to demand an end to the policy of administrative detention.
- Jerusalemite detainee Ameen Shweiki continues his strike for diabetes treatment for the 205th consecutive day in protest of his administrative detention.
