- The International Foundation for Solidarity with Prisoners (Tadamon) launches its tenth international campaign of solidarity (Ramadan in captivity) coinciding with the Palestinian Prisoner's Day.

- The Israeli occupation arrests 470 Palestinian citizens after attacking them in the blessed Al-Aqsa Mosque.



- The lawyer of the detainee, Ahmed Manasra: "The occupation court has dropped the definition of "terrorism file" (according to the court's description) from the case of the detainee Ahmed Manasra, which makes it possible to seek in the case of his early release."

- Salem Military Court sentences the detainee Alaa El-Din Muhammad Ali Fayed from Jenin camp to 13 years in prison and a fine of 40,000 shekels.
- In the month of Ramadan, the Israeli occupation prisons administration prevents the families of Jenin detainees from visiting as part of punitive measures against the people of the governorate.
- Under the slogan "Our decision is freedom"... the administrative detainees in the occupation prisons continue to boycott the occupation courts for the 107th consecutive day to demand an end to the policy of administrative detention.
- Jerusalemite detainee Ameen Shweiki continues his strike for diabetes treatment for the 212th consecutive day in protest of his administrative detention.
- The Israeli occupation prisons administration continues the solitary confinement, in difficult sanitary conditions, for each of the following detainees: Detainee Wael Al-Jaghoub - Megiddo Prison for the 655th day in a row, Detainee Yasser Abu Turki - Nafha prison for the 465th day in a row, The injured detainee Haitham Ibrahim Ballal - Gilboa prison for the 378th day in a row, Detainee Rifaat Abu Fara - "Negev Desert" prison for the 331st day in a row, Detainee Ahmed Juma'a Abu Jazar in the cells of Ashkelon Prison for 310th day in a row, Detainee Malik Ahmed Hamed in the cells of "Megiddo" prison for 230th days in a row., Detainee Thaer Hammad in the cells of "Nafha" prison for 126th days in a row, Detainee Ashraf Abu Srour - "Aholikdar" prison many months ago, Detainee Ayman Haj Yahya in the cells of "Raymond" prison many months ago, Detainee Rabie Abu Al-Nawas, Detainee Mahmoud Al-Ardah, Detainee Mohammed Al-Ardah, Detainee Zakaria Zubeidi, Detainee Ayham Kamamji, Detainee Munadil Nfe'at, Detainee Yaqoub Qadri.

- The mother of the detainee Ahmed Manasra: "I am a mother, they did not make me closer to my son, I used to look at him and the jailer deliberately closed him."
- "Al-Nahshon" forces of the occupation assaulted the detainee Mahmoud Al-Ardah during the court session in Nazareth today, after he said that he wanted to escape from prison to tell the nation that "this monster is an illusion of dust."
- Detainee Ayham Kammaji during the trial session in Nazareth court today: "I am sentenced to life imprisonment and have been isolated from my family for 7 years, and my goal in escaping from Gilboa prison was to visit my mother's grave and I do not regret that."
- Detainee Yaqoub Qadri during the trial session in Nazareth court today: "I suffer from pain so far and we are subjected to medical neglect in prison."
- The detainee, Rabie Abu Al-Nawas, is surprised by the start of the month of Ramadan due to his isolation in a solitary cell, as he realized this during his mother and wife's visit to him in Al-Ramlah prison.
- For the 45th consecutive day, the detainee Khalil Awawda (40 years), from the town of Ithna, west of Hebron, continues his hunger strike in order to reject his administrative detention in the occupation prisons.
- The occupation transfers the detainee Ammar Yasser Al-Omour from Ofer Prison to the so-called hospital "prison" of Al-Ramlah, after he fell ill, and his family demands his immediate release, after he spent nearly 13 months without any judgment.
- Quoting his family: The Israeli occupation transfers the detainee sentenced to life imprisonment, Omar Al-Abed, from the town of Kober, north of Ramallah, to the court, without knowing the reason.
- He was arrested hours before the holy month of Ramadan.. The occupation transfers the deported Jerusalemite MP Ahmed Atoun to
