• "Dawn of the Detainees"... The International Foundation for Solidarity with Prisoners (Tadamon) organizes a special program within the activities of the "Great Dawn" in solidarity with detainees in Israeli occupation prisons on the occasion of the Palestinian Detainee Day.

• As part of the "Ramadan in Captivity" campaign, (Tadamon) organizes solidarity activities in several European cities in solidarity with Palestinian detainees in occupation prisons on the occasion of Palestinian Detainee Day.

• On the day of the Palestinian detainee, about (4450) detainees are in the occupation prisons, including (32) female detainees, (160) children under the age of 18, (600) administrative detainees, and (549) serving life sentences.

- For the 53rd day in a row, the detainee Khalil Awawda (40 years), from the town of Ithna, west of Hebron, continues his hunger strike in protest of his administrative detention in the occupation prisons.
- For the 28th day in a row, the detainee Raed Rayan (27 years), from the village of Beit Duqqu, northwest of Jerusalem, continues his open hunger strike to protest his administrative detention.
- The occupation releases all detainees from Al-Aqsa Mosque last Friday, with the exception of five young men: Abdullah Jabareen, Muhammad Kitana, Mahdi Abu Al-Hassan, Basil Shemy, and Muhammad Khamaysa.
- The PFLP in the Occupation Prisons: If the occupation renews the administrative detention of the leader, Bashir Al-Khairi, a large number of detainees will go on an open hunger strike.
- Detainees Committee: The detainees Ziad Hammouda and Abdul Majeed Mahdi joined the list of "deans of detainees", thus raising the list to (187) detainees.
- Wadi Hilweh Information Center: "More than 520 decisions of expulsion from Al-Aqsa Mosque against Palestinians, issued by the occupation since the beginning of the holy month of Ramadan."
- The Israeli occupation transfers the administrative detainee Sheikh Amin Arman, residents of Ramallah; From Ofer Prison to the Negev Desert Prison.
- The occupation summons the mother of the detained child, Athal Al-Azza, 14, from Al-Azza refugee camp, for interrogation, while it has so far refused to release him, as he was arrested last Friday near the northern entrance to Bethlehem.
- Tension prevailed in the Negev prison after the occupation forces stormed Section 24 and kidnapped the Friday preacher among the detainees.
- The occupation forces arrest Sheikh Ismat Al-Hammoury from his home in the town of Beit Hanina in Jerusalem.
- Under the slogan "Our decision is freedom"... the administrative detainees in the occupation prisons continue to boycott the occupation courts for the 111th consecutive day to demand an end to the policy of administrative detention.
- Jerusalemite detainee Ameen Shweiki continues his strike for diabetes treatment for the 219th consecutive day in protest of his administrative detention.
