- 3 detainees continue their hunger strike to reject administrative detention and solitary confinement in Israeli occupation prisons.

- The occupation transfers the cancer patient, detainee Nasser Abu Hamid, to Tel Hashomer Hospital, after a new deterioration in his health condition.



- Ofer Prison administration transferred 52 detainees from the PFLP to solitary confinement, after they protested against the renewal of the administrative detention of detainee Bashir al-Khairi (80 years).

- The wounded detainee, Nour El-Din Jerboa from Jenin camp, is subjected to the policy of deliberate medical neglect and slow killing, and the administration of the occupation prisons had previously transferred him from the hospital to Al-Ramlah Prison Clinic, despite the seriousness of his health condition.
- For the 59th day in a row, the detainee Khalil Awawda (40 years), from the town of Ithna, west of Hebron, continues his open hunger strike in rejection of his administrative detention in the occupation prisons.
- For the 25th consecutive day, the detainee Raed Rayan (27 years), from the village of Beit Duqu, northwest of Jerusalem, continues his open hunger strike to protest the renewal of his administrative detention for the second time.
- The detainee Abdullah Al-Ardah is on a hunger strike to reject the occupation's decision to extend his solitary confinement for two more months, knowing that he has been in isolation since September 6, 2021 after the Gilboa Tunnel operation.
- The Israeli Occupation Prisons Administration is conducting transfers for detainees of Freedom Tunnel Operation, including the detainees Mahmoud, Muhammad Al-Ardah, Yaqoub Qadri, Ayham Kammaji, Munadil Enfaia, Qusai Marei, Mahmoud Abu shreen and Zakaria Al-Zubaidi.
- The occupation prisons administration continues its crime against the cancer patient, detainee Iyad Nazir Omar (40

years), from Jenin camp, where the prison administration deliberately delays conducting the necessary examinations at the specified time, especially since time is the main factor in containing any possibility of a worsening of his health.

- The occupation sentences the detainee Khalil Dwaikat from Nablus to life imprisonment on charges of carrying out a stabbing attack last year in Petah Tikva that resulted in the killing of a settler.
- The occupation releases the cancer patient, detainee Abdel Baset Maatan, from the village of Burqa, southeast of Ramallah, after a long suffering with medical negligence.
- The Occupation Court sentences the detainee of Jerusalem, Nawal Muhammad Fatiha, to an actual prison term of 8 years and pays a fine of 30,000 shekels. She has been in detention for 26 months.
- The occupation releases the sick detainee Saleh Saleh from Nablus after spending five years in captivity in Al-Ramlah Clinic prison, where he suffers from hemiplegia as a result of an injury he sustained and relies on a wheelchair to move around.
- The occupation forces released the child Athal Al-Azza from Bethlehem after 12 days of detention.
- The Occupation Court in Jerusalem sentenced the Jerusalemite detainee Louay Jaber to 40 months in prison and a fine of 4000 shekels.
- The occupation isolates the detainee Ali Al-

- Under the slogan "Our decision is freedom"... the administrative detainees in the occupation prisons continue to boycott the occupation courts for the 118th

consecutive day to demand an end to the policy of administrative detention.

- Jerusalemite detainee Ameen Shweiki continues his strike for diabetes treatment for the 226th consecutive day in protest of his administrative detention.
