- The death of the mother of the dean of Palestinian detainees, Karim Younes, months before his release and after he spent 40 years in the prisons of the occupation.

- The detainee Khalil Awawda (40 years), from the village of Idna, south of Hebron, continues his hunger strike for the 67th consecutive day, and the detainee Raed Rayan (27 years), from the village of Beit Duqo, north of occupied Jerusalem, is on hunger strike for the 32nd day; To protest their administrative detention.

- The occupation army blew up the house of detainee Omar Jaradat during the storming of Al-Silat Al-Harithiya town in Jenin, as the occupation accused him of carrying out the Homesh operation last December.

- The Occupation Prisons Administration returns the detainee, Khalil Awawda, who has been on hunger strike for 67 days, to Ramleh prison, after transferring him to Assaf Harofeh Hospital, as a result of the seriousness of his health condition.
- Head of Hamas in Gaza, Yahya Sinwar: The occupation government lies to its public and thinks that the prisoners' file can be folded into oblivion, and there are no red lines that prevent us from fulfilling our duty towards our detainees.
- On World Press Freedom Day, 15 Palestinian journalists are imprisoned by the Israeli occupation.
- The occupation releases the deputy director of the Islamic Endowments in Jerusalem, Sheikh Najeh Bakirat, on condition of house arrest for 5 days and a bail of six thousand shekels.
- For the fifth time in a row.. the occupation court renewed the administrative detention of the detainee Hassan Shehadeh from Bethlehem for a period of 3 months, and he has been in detention for 21 months.
- For the fifth time in a row, the Military Occupation Court renewed the administrative detention of the detainee Yasser Abu Sharar from Jericho for a period of two months, knowing that he had been detained for 18 months.
- The Military Occupation Court extended the detention of journalist Ayman Qawariq

for a week. He was arrested on April 28, while passing through Qalandia Checkpoint, and was taken to investigations at the Al-Maskobiya Center.

- The Occupation Court issues an administrative detention order for a period of 6 months against the detainee, the leader of the PFLP, Abdullah Afif Zakarna, from Jenin, who was arrested at the Za'tara checkpoint two weeks ago.
- The Military Occupation Court transferred the detainee Sheikh Ali Abu Al-Rub from Qabatiya, south of Jenin, to administrative detention for a period of 3 months.
- The occupation releases the detainee Khitam Saafin from the town of Beitunia, Ramallah, after 19 months of detention.
- Occupation police arrest two Palestinian minors from the occupied city of Haifa, for allegedly lowering the Israeli flag from an electricity pole.
- Under the slogan "Our decision is freedom"... the administrative detainees in the occupation prisons continue to boycott the occupation courts for the 125th consecutive day to demand an end to the policy of administrative detention.
- Jerusalemite detainee Ameen Shweiki continues his strike for diabetes treatment for the 233rd consecutive day in protest of his administrative detention.
