



- International Solidarity Prisoners Institute "Tadamon" in association with " Al- Yagatha" Observatory for Human Rights and Fair Causes established The Prisoners Ambassadors program.
- Prisoner Naser Abu Hmaed's health condition is rapidly declining as he went through two chemo-therapy sessions gith his weight registering a low of 52 kilograms.
- Khaleel Al- Awawdeh (40 years old) is on the 108th day of his hunger strike alongside Ra'ed Rayan (27 years old) on his 73th day in protest to their administrative detention.









- According to the Prisoners and the Liberated
 Affairs organisation, since the beginning of
 this year the Israeli occupation authorities
 arrested 450 Palestinian children, 353 of
 which are residents of Jerusalem, making a
 78.4% majority.
- Today marks the 8th anniversary of Israeli authorities arresting 70 of the Liberated prisoners in "Wafaa' Al- Ahrar" deal.
- 5 prisoners carry-on their hunger strike in protest of their administrative detention.
- Salem martial court sentenced Muna Hasan
 Qa'dan (50 years old) from Arabeh village,
 south of Jenin to 18 months in prison and
 7,000 Shekels fine.
- Samer Sa'eed Radwan's family pleads for all law and human rights institutions to provide proper medical care for their son.

- The Israeli authorities holdes 18 sick prisoners captives in the so called Ar-ramleh clinic under unsanitary conditions and lack of basic medical equipment, including 70

- Israeli magistrate's court in Ar-ramleh concluded its session regarding the decision in classifying Ahmad Mansasra's case under the Terrorism Law without a final decision, in presence of the specialised committee.

 The committee was supposed to determine the possibility of transferring the case to the Early Parole committee.
- Prisoners Club reported: "The Israeli court decision to convict Architect Mohammad Al-Halabi (44 years old) under many chrages is a systematic vengeance for his 6-years struggle and determination to refuse the charges a...
- The "Two thirds" committee decided to conduct a new court session for Fo'ad Hijazi Al- Shobaki (82 years old), the oldest prisoner on the 5th of July.
