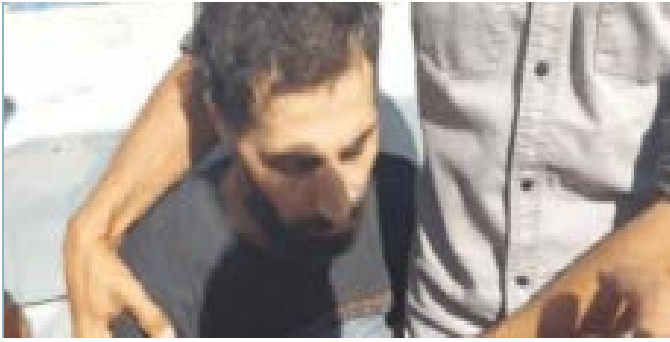

- Ra'ed Rayyan suspends his 113- days-long hunger strike after victoriously getting a deal for his release.
- Khaleel Al- Awawdeh is on the 114th day of open-end hunger strike in protest of his administrative detention despite the grave dangers to his health.
- The Prisoners Committee stated: "Cancer patient prisoner Naser Abu Humeideh's health is rapidly declining, reaching a critical point"

- Israeli occupation authorities released Mohammad Awni Obeid amnesic and in poor health after 18 months in captivity. His family confirmed that he had no health conditions or illnesses prior to his arrest.
- Israeli occupation authorities moved the Jerusalem-based activist Salah Al- Hamawi to Hadareem prison after classifying him “extremely dangerous”. Al- Hamawi endures brutal treatment and punishment. He is handcuffed and shackled for most of the day and is constantly harassed during the night with frequent cell inspections.
- The Israeli prison service authorized the savage attack on the unarmed prisoners in Ofer prison injuring one of the prisoners.
- The Israeli public prosecution put forward an indictment against Maryam Abu Qweider, a student at Beir As- Sabe’ University currently under house arrest. The indictment included charges such as: “endorsing a terrorist organization and instigating terrorism”. Prosecution demanded extending the house arrest order as well as blocking her access to the web.
- The Zionist courts sentenced Aida Al- Masri to 7 months of actual prison time and Amneh Ishteah to 8 months as well as fines. Both Amneh and Aida are students of An- Najah University.
- The Israeli prison service transported Mahmoud Abu Atieh to Ramon’s infamous solitary confinement cells. Abu Atieh faces
- The Israeli prison service transported Mahmoud Salem As- Sarahneh from Asqalan solitary confinement cells to Ramon’s cells. The 45-year-old Ad- Daheisheh refugees camp resident has been in solitary confinement for 14 days straight.
- The Israeli authorities denied Ayham Riyad Ghanem’s mother’s visitation rights. In spite of the fact that she possesses a clearance pass, she was forced her to turn back around from Al- Jalameh passage northeast of Jenin. Ayham is the brother of the martyr Rafeeq Ghanem.
- The Israeli courts sentenced Abd Al- Hameed Abu Hanieh to 3 and a half years of actual prison time and a 6-thousand-shekels fine. Abu Hanieh has previously served a 6-years-long sentence.
- Prisoners continuing their Empty Stomachs battle:
 - Khaleel Al- Awawdeh, 40 years old, from Ethna village west of Hebron is on his 151st consecutive day in protest to his administrative detention.
 - Mo’taz Obeido is on his 39th consecutive day in protest of the medical negligence policy.
 - Fikri Mansour is on his 30th consecutive day in protest on his transportation to the criminal offenses section in Ayalon prison.
